Officers Reports:

President – Denise Miller

Getting more black bibs so that the winner can keep it. Also getting fore runner bibs. Fore runners must have a bib and waiver signed by the parents.

Computer Software & Results – Steve Coatney

The 400 number range guest bibs are problematic so don't use them, only use the 900 number bibs. There were some questions raised about Micheal Thomas. A starter made a mistake he was put in the wrong race, it has been corrected and he has been upgraded from E2 to E1. Alex Schultz was upgraded to E1 too. The delays on Saturday and Sunday were due to installation delay on the laptop. These issues have been resolved. Will try to print the start sheets during the week. Looking for a new computer, cost should be around \$500. The race results got put up late due to some laptop issues. It was suggested to not make the race results final tonight, but I was decided to let them be final and would consider any valid protest.
