

# The MACC Numbers for 2005

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## Summary

This season our numbers were nearly the same as last year. We started out a little better, but did not have as many late season registrations. The distribution of classes on five courses worked well and does not need adjustment for 2006 unless our numbers drop significantly (in which case we need to go to four courses). Our numbers dropped a little in the Vet E1 and E1 men's classes and Vet-A women, grew a little in the Super Vet A and B classes, and were not much different in the other classes. However, there are two cases where we should remove classes for 2006:

- The Vet-A and A women's classes average less than 10 combined. The Vet-A women's class should be removed.
- The Vet-B and B men's classes also average less than 10 combined. (Most of the drop was in Vet-B between 2004 and 2005). The Vet-B men's class should be removed (following the same history of Vet-D and Vet-C).

## Data for 2005

Table 1 shows our turnout for each year since 1992 (except 1995—no data). All numbers shown in this report are based on attendance, not registration. Searchmont numbers are shown in italics starting in 1996. Our numbers at Boyne have been very similar for the past three years and at Searchmont for the past two years. The averages in the column "Byne" do not include Searchmont or the Cantor Cup. In 2000 and 2002, the "Byne" average only included the first 6 races due to late-season weather problems.

Attendance for the Cantor Cup continues to drop. However, this year, the new format was not communicated very well, and the event ran quickly and smoothly. The permanent workers (course crew, equipment, etc.) were universally happy that things were finished by 1:30 on Sunday.

Table 2 shows how the numbers in each class have changed since 1992. Overall, we are gaining elite racers, keeping supervet racers, and losing intermediate young and vet racers.

Table 5 shows the attendance histories of the clubs since 1992. This year, the main gains came from the Renegades, Thunderbirds, and Toledo. There were significant losses with Schussmeisters and Snow Drifters. (The 20005 averages do not include the Cantor Cup.)

Table 6 shows the club votes for 2006, based on the turnout for the first 11 races from 2005. It takes a total of 55 racer starts to get a vote, 132 to get two votes, and 330 to get three votes. GM got their vote back, but Snow Drifters lost a vote. The total number of votes is still 16, and a quorum for MACC in 2006 is still 9 voting members.
