

# The MACC Numbers for the 2013 Season

## Summary

Our numbers dropped this year back to the levels we had three years ago (2010). At that time, we could blame it on the Michigan economy. Indeed, as the economy improved (2011, 2012), so did our numbers.

This time, we can't expect that the numbers will improve due to factors outside our control. Most of the losses are with the youngest racers (ages 15 – 23). If our program is to survive through the coming decades, we must bring in younger racers.

The current four-course schedule is near the limit from the point of view of having enough workers. We should prepare for the possibility of running with three courses next year if our numbers do not go back up for 2014. (Better solution: more racers!)

The Renegade and Skiniks teams lost votes, so next year the MACC will have 11 votes, with 6 votes needed for a quorum.

## MACC Team Attendance and Votes

Table 1 shows the team turnout for 2013 and the resulting team votes for 2014. The table also includes a column **Reg.** that indicates the number of racers who registered with each team. The total registration is 172; last year, it was 181.

It takes 55 racer starts for a team to get a vote, 132 to get two votes, and 330 to get three votes. Next year the MACC teams will have 11 votes, a decrease of two from last year as the Renegades lost their vote and Skiniks went from two to one vote. GM dropped out as a team.

For comparison over past years, Table 2 shows the attendance histories of the current teams since 1992.

## Turnout per Race

Table 3 shows our turnout for each year going back to 1992 (except 1995—no files). Searchmont numbers are shown in italics starting in 1996. The averages in the column “Boyne” do not include Searchmont or the Cantor Cup. The averages in the column “Ave” do not include the Cantor Cup for years after 1998. These numbers do include guest racers.

In most years prior to 2010, the turnout at Searchmont was between 60% and 75% of the turnout at Boyne. Since 2010, it's been closer to 40%; this year, it was only 38%.

## Courses and Classes

Table 4 shows the attendance for the courses. On regular four-course days at Boyne, course 1 had as many as 51 racers, while course 4 had as few as 21 racers.

## Age Distribution

Table 6 shows information about the distribution of our racers by age over the past few years. Ages were based on Dec 31 before the first race of the season. It gives the number of registered racers in each age group, with unknown ages being listed under '?'. The last three columns give ages at 25 percentile intervals: last season, 25% of our racers were 43 or younger, 50% were 52 or younger, and 75% were 59 or younger. That means about a quarter of our racers are between 52 and 59, and half are between 43 and 59.

Although the table has just a few years of data, it shows that we are dominated by baby boomers, many who aged from the 40-49 group into the 50-59 group.

Our numbers have been stable over the past few years for ages 50 – 69. We have lost racers in the 40 – 49 group and in the youngest groups (15 – 23).
