General Updates – Alex Carrico – No questions or comments on minutes. Alan motions to approve, Ginnie seconds. None opposed, minutes approved.

Races 8 and 9 went well, no issues with high school racers sharing hill. Slight issue with comp tickets, but that was sorted out. Course setters gate shack caught fire due to an old space heater. We were able to put it out, and Mark brought engineers over to fix it. Alex and Drew will talk to Boyne to insure there are fire extinguishers in each building.

This weekend we will have slalom on Friday on North Boyne. Registration will be in the same place as before, back of civic center. Saturday races will be back on FIS. Race 12 is the Cantor Cup. It will be one run of super G and one run of slalom.

Updates from Boyne – Mark has gathered all the equipment that we need for Friday. If there is anything that you need that mark hasn't already grabbed, let Alex know and she will reach out for us. If it's something small, please take care of it yourself. Schedule says there will be awards on Friday, but because we are on North Boyne, we will be moving them to Saturday, immediately after the race. The awards after the race will be for races 9 and 10 for sure. If we have time, we will also do Saturdays race (race 11). If we don't have time, we will do it at the banquet like normal. For the World Cup standings, because we had to cancel the first weekend, you only get two drops. One must be GS and one must be slalom; Super G can't be dropped. Cantor Cup awards will be done on Superbowl, either at the bottom of the hill or on the deck.

Banquet – If you have a Bernie Bast award nomination, let Alex know. They have a few but are open to more suggestions. For the raffle prizes, we do have a temporary raffle license along with some large prizes from sponsors. Each person coming to the banquet will get one ticket with banquet purchase. That ticket is good for the main prize drawing: t-shirts, poles, gloves, etc. (the smaller items). For the larger prizes: skis, gold pass, foot beds, etc. we will be selling raffle tickets. They will be \$5 a ticket or 5 tickets for \$20. Skiers will be able to put the tickets into a drawing for each individual item. Banquet tickets must be purchased ahead of time, online sales will be shut down Thursday night, but can be bought in person with cash between 8:30 and 11:30 on Friday.

Updates – Drew Hilger – No Updates.

Registration – Ginnie Uhley – Two possible guest racers. No other updates.

Handicaps and Statistics – Chuck White – Full set of pacesetters. A few last-minute changes, so a revised schedule will go out tonight or tomorrow. Handicap committee will be started up again this spring, will notify all old members and look for new ones.

Course Operations – Dennis Parrott – We have a full set of workers. Gate judges are thin on course 2 Saturday. Both courses Sunday only have 1. One other thing to note is that if you have a radio, Dennis will pick it up after the cantor cup concludes.

Course Officials – Jenessa Hilger – We had one informal protest. Racer self-disqualified voluntarily. Results have been partially updated, but we will get it sorted out.

Course Setting – Kermit Anderson – Not on call, but he told Alex they are all set on course setters. Weather looks good as of right now.

Equipment – Dave Carrico – Got some quotes for new equipment but will bring up the details in the fall. Good on everything else for this weekend.

Timing – Shawn Hughes – Timer schedule is out. Will not be there this weekend though.

Race workers – Bill Perlmutter – Not on the call.

Computers – Steve Coatney – Results are posted, move to approve them assuming the overall results for race 8 are corrected. Mike Sayers motions, Alan seconds. Results approved. Had to buy a new printer for the shack, it was about \$60.

Awards – Zach Jablonski – Not on the call.

Publicity – Debi Koltoniak – Will let people know that we are on North Boyne and that registration is in the Ramshead room. Same registration hours as usual. Online tickets close on Thursday, around 8pm. Tickets can be bought with cash or check Friday morning. Will let everyone know about awards timings and raffle structure.

Webmaster – Mike Sayers – On the homepage, will add Friday race location and banquet ticket cutoff times. Also, website has a few more updates, with Facebook and YouTube links.
