**General Updates – Drew Hilger** – Motion to approve the minutes from Jan 18<sup>th</sup>? Motion from Mike Sayers, second from Alan. Nobody opposed, minutes approved.

**Updates – Shawn Hughes** – Will talk to Kurt about a request from Boyne. They are looking for a timer to help work one of their races. Steve – Devon reached out to see if he could do it, but he can't. He is available to help explain to someone else what needs to be done.

**Finances – Mike Hietbrink** – We have our raffle license for this year. About \$14,800 in accounts. We don't have invoices for bibs or awards yet. Please send to mike so they get paid.

**Registration** – **Ginnie Uhley** – Current registration is at 89 racers. One new racer from Skiwis, requested a qualifier. Will talk to some other Skiwis to see what class they think he should go in. There were some issues with the bib sizing, they are looking into it, to see why they are all smaller compared to last time. We won't be able to resolve this by this weekend unfortunately, so we will have to use the same bibs. Invoice should go directly to mike when it goes through. Won't be there Friday, so Alex will be stepping in to help with registration. Same registration hours, and Alex will have the computer.

**Handicaps and Statistics – Chuck White** – For handicaps, we should have a full crew of pacesetters. Don't have many alternates but should be good for this weekend.

Course Operations – Dennis Parrott – The online banquet ticket sales code has been deployed to website. It isn't active yet but should be easy to launch once we get pricing info. We typically shut it down Thursday before the marks weekend and then we have in person sales on that Friday. Basically, ready to go, just waiting on pricing.

Course ops is pretty thinly staffed for this weekend. Would like to add to the newsletter that we are looking for help. Anyone that wants to help can just meet up with course workers at the top of the hill and slip with them. Faith in the group we do have, but numbers are a bit low. We usually pull batteries at the end of the season, but this season a lot of batteries failed. Replaced quite a few last weekend and ordered more.

**Course Officials – Jenessa Hilger** – No protests. Didn't have the video finished for last newsletter, but it is ready and posted now. It goes over all the common faults, to help gate keepers.

**Course Setting – Kermit Anderson** – We will be one short on Friday but will still be good to go.
